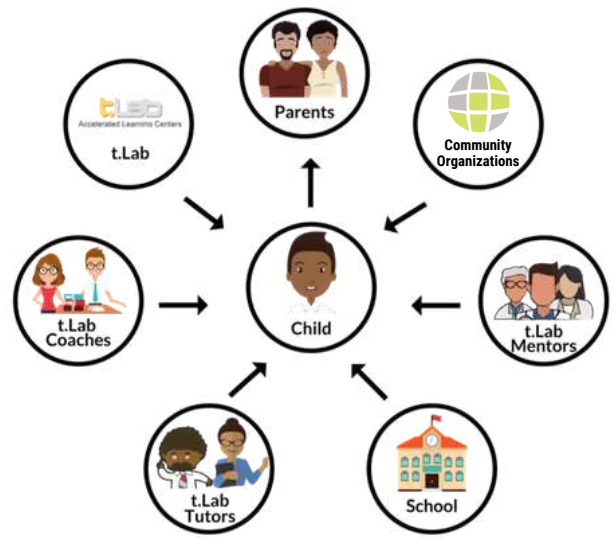




# t.Lab *at a glance*

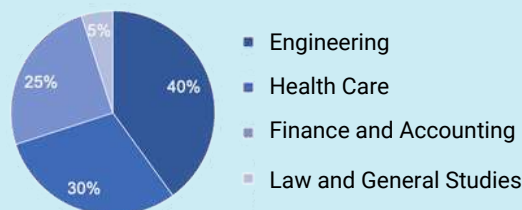
